The title should be in Bold and Italic Arial, 14pt and the name(s) of the author(s), department(s), institution(s) and e-mail address(es) in regular Arial 11pt

The maximum length is 300 words including keywords and phrases

Full contact details, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number(s) and institutional affiliation of authors must be given

A conference sub-theme for which the paper should be considered must be indicated on the abstract submission form

Presentations will be limited to 20 minutes plus a 10 minute question/discussion session

The abstract submission form and the registration form are separate documents

A poster session will be scheduled on the programme
