

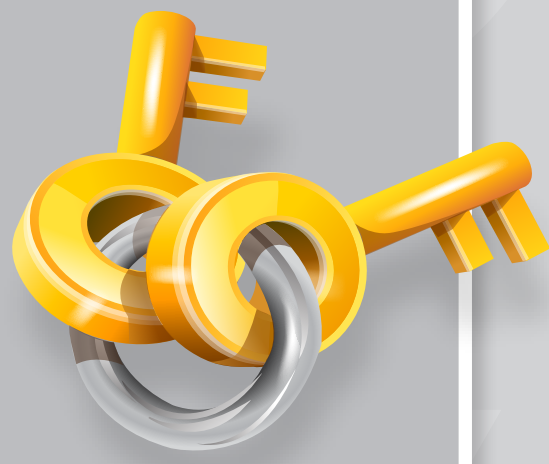

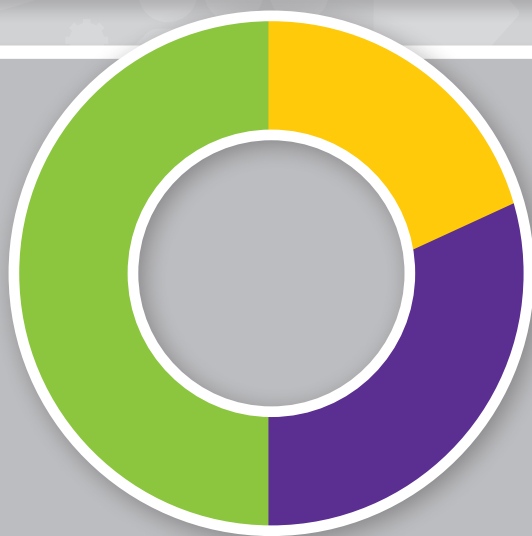

Apartheid legacy and social challenges have an impact

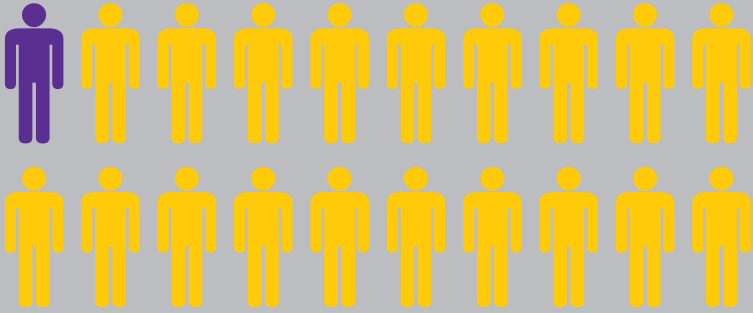


The South African government has to overcome years of under investment in **black education** under apartheid.

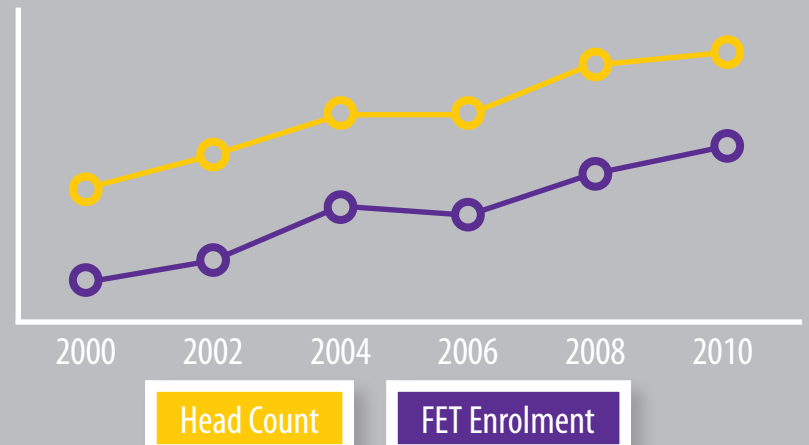
