Note to Revision Service 8

The Deeds Practice Manuals have been updated to reflect the law as at 31 December 2013.

After numerous requests by subscribers and other users of this publication, together with the need to accommodate an ever expanding title, a decision was taken that the content of the Deeds Practice Manuals should be split into two volumes.

One of the suggestions received was that the Sectional Titles Manual should be in the same binder as the Conventional Deeds Manual, a suggestion we agreed with. The new Volume 1 therefore consists of the Conventional Deeds Manual and the Sectional Titles Manual and Volume 2 of the other three Manuals. The supplementary material is printed in both Volume 1 and Volume 2 to allow the independent use of the two binders. The page numbering of the new Manual 2 (Sectional Titles Manual) and the new Manual 4 (Diverse Legislation Manual) has had to be adapted to reflect this move.

We strongly believe that the change will add value to this product and that the publication will be more user-friendly. As part of this revision service (RS) all subscribers will receive a full set of all the pages in the Deeds Practice Manuals, albeit that pages of which the content has not been updated since RS 7 in 2013 will retain their old RS numbers in their running footers.

In 2014 we continue the practice initially followed only in the Sectional Titles Manual in respect of RCRs, namely to reproduce the content of each RCR referred to in the text in a footnote. Any reference to an RCR on a page that in any case forms part of RS 8 will be accompanied by a footnote in which the content of such RCR is quoted. If any RCR on a page that forms part of RS 8 is not followed by a footnote, it most probably implies that a reference to such RCR, together with a footnote in which the content of such RCR is found, does appear somewhere on the immediately preceding pages.

All the indices (statutes, cases, CRCs, RCRs, subject index) have been updated to include references to the content of RS 8.

If there are any mistakes in this publication, the input of any subscriber or other user in that regard will be much appreciated.
