NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE THE AIRPORTS COMPANY AMENDMENT BILL, 2017 INTO PARLIAMENT IN TERMS OF THE RULE 241(1) (b) OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

The Minister of Transport hereby in terms of National Assembly Rule No.241(1) (b) intends introducing the Airports Company Amendment Bill, 2017 ("the Bill") in Parliament during 2017.

The Bill and its Explanatory Memorandum were published for a comment in Government Gazette No. 38279 dated 02 December 2014 and is called the Airports Company Amendment Bill, 2017.

The object of the Bill is as follows:-

To amend the Airports Company Act, 1993, so as to insert and substitute certain definitions; to align Airport Company Act with the Companies Act, 2008 and Public Finance Management Act, 1999; to provide for the appointment and disqualification of members of the Committee; to provide for the vacation of office of members of the Committee; to provide for meetings of the Committee; to amend the period for the issuing of a permission; to provide for decisions of the Committee; to provide for the establishment of the Appeal Committee; to provide for the vacation of office of members of the Appeal Committee; to provide for the vacation of office of members of the Appeal Committee; to provide for appeals against the decisions of the Committee; to provide for substitution of certain citations and expressions and to provide for matters connected herewith.
