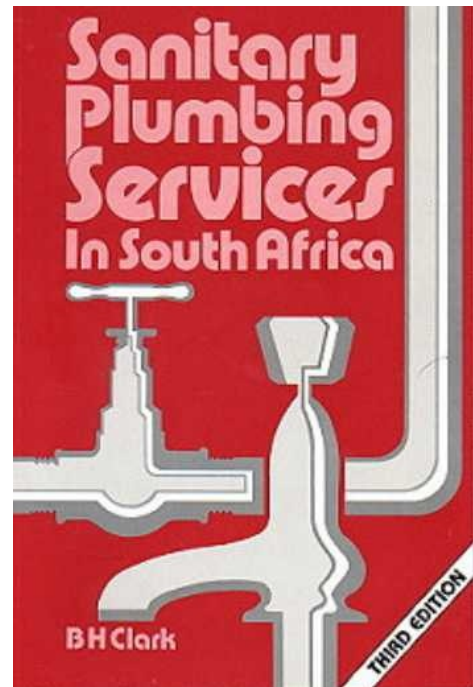


Sanitary Plumbing Services in South Africa
