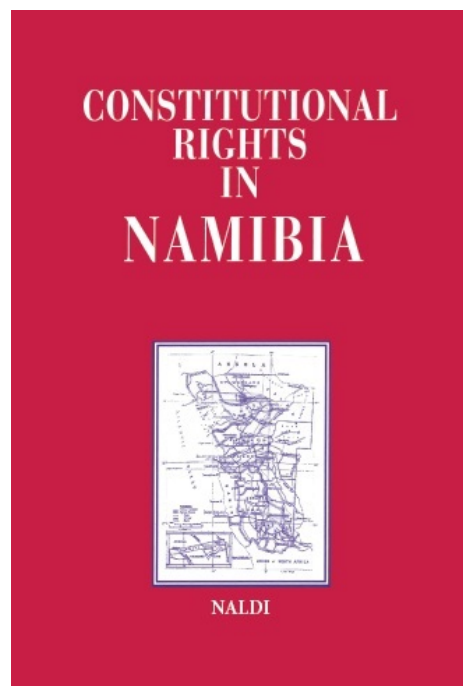


# Constitutional Rights in Namibia
