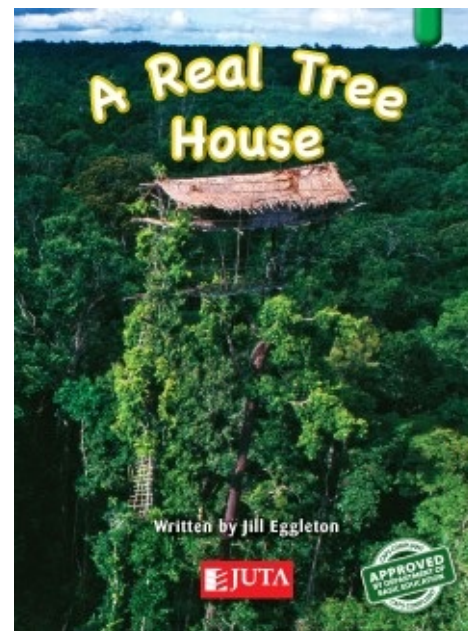


# A Real Tree House
