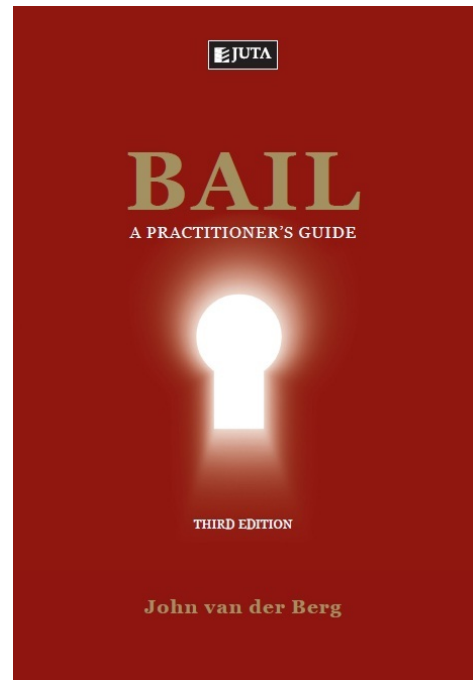


Bail: A Practitioner's Guide
