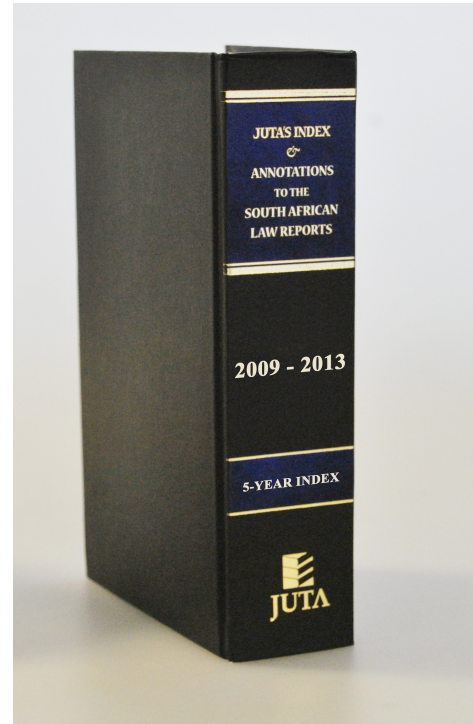


Index and Annotations to the South African Law Reports, Juta's (2009-2013)
