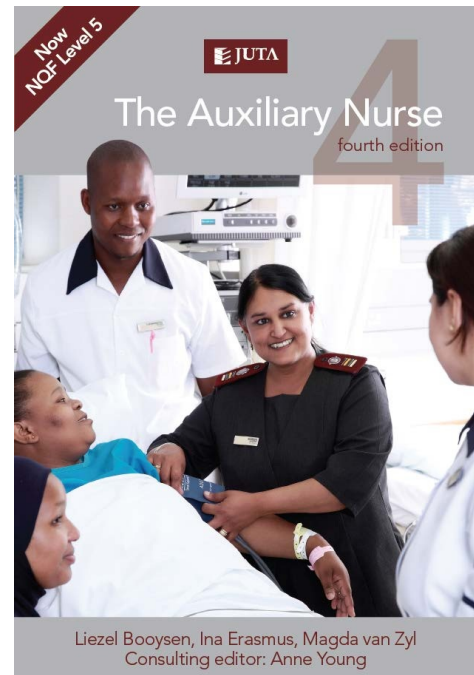


Auxiliary Nurse, The
