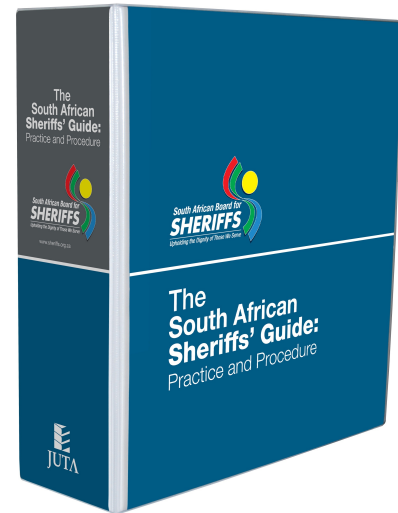


South African Sheriffs' Guide, The
