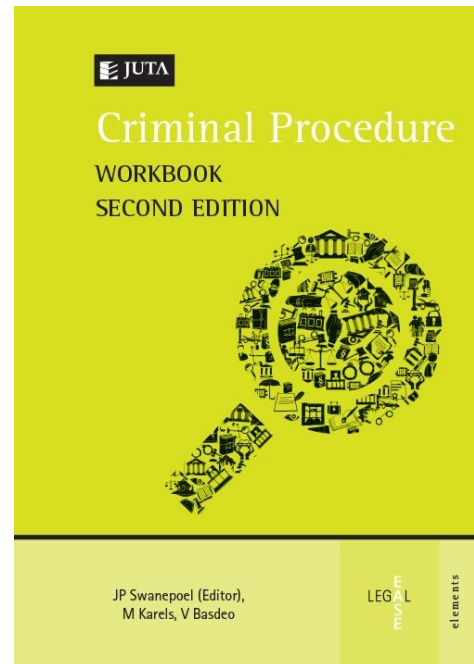


Criminal Procedure Workbook
