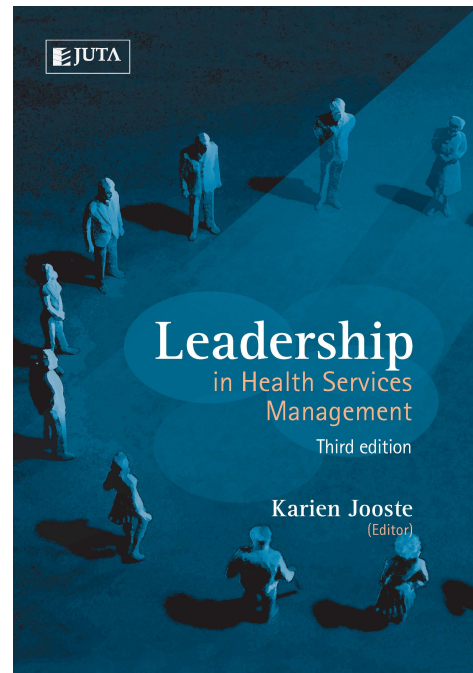


Leadership in Health Services Management
