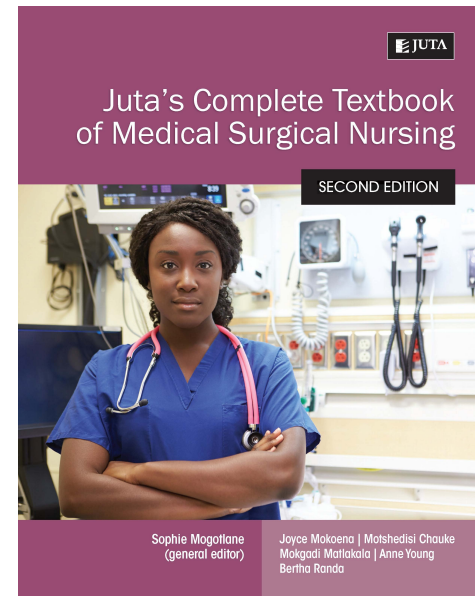

What's NEW in the 2nd edition:
