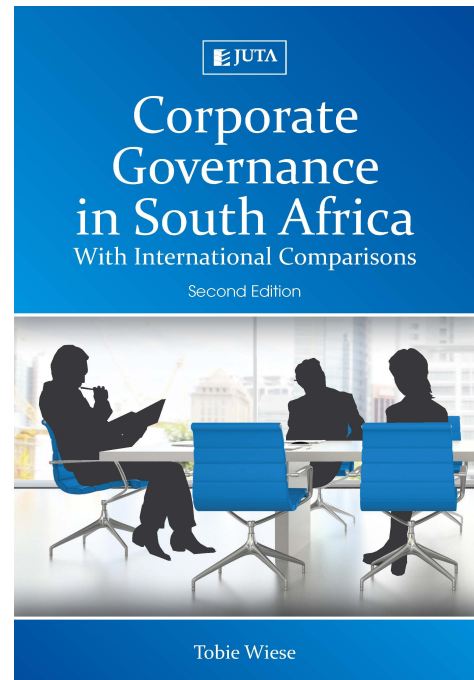


Corporate Governance in South Africa
