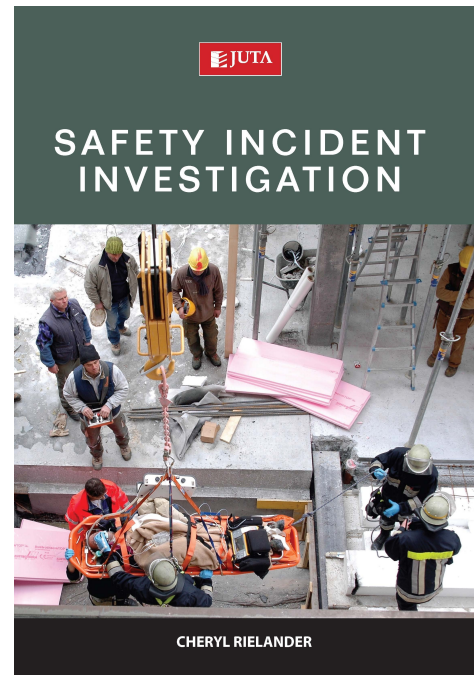


Safety Incident Investigation
