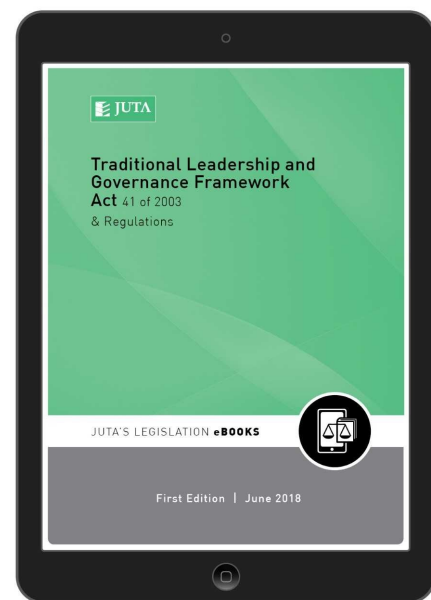


# Traditional Leadership and Governance Framework Act 41 of 2003 & Related Material (eBook)
